## Family Funded House



Habitat for Humanity of Hood County builds 4 houses a year. All of these houses are special, but we choose one house a year to honor our Habitat families.

This year it is Habitat House #38. On May 26<sup>th</sup> we dedicated this 3-bedroom house, built in Rancho Brazos Development. This house is a ***“Family Funded Habitat Home”***.

What that means is, a portion of each house payment from all Habitat Families goes into a fund. This fund buys building materials to construct one Habitat home a year in Hood County! **CONGRATULATIONS Habitat home owners, this is the 3<sup>rd</sup> “Family Funded Habitat Home” built in Hood County!**

With each house payment a Habitat family makes on their home, they can be proud of the fact that they are helping other families. Of course everyone that has donated time or money to this housing ministry can be proud, indeed!

The other houses that we normally build each year will continue to be funded by donations from the community of Hood County.

And thanks to the generosity of this wonderful community, there are 60 adults and 85 children living in Habitat homes in Hood County.

Our next four families have started working on their sweat equity hours, families must put in 300 hours each, by helping build their home and other families' homes. With these families bring eight children. ## Our Tithe Working in Kyrgyzstan

Habitat for Humanity of Hood County is a Christian ministry and therefore we tithe ten percent of our undesignated contributions. Our tithe from 1996 through December 2006, was \$120,643. We believe that those who support this ministry should know where our tithe is being sent and that it is being used properly. HFHI allows each affiliate to designate where they want their tithe sent. For our first six years, we sent our tithe to General Santos City in the Philippines. Since 2003, our tithe money has been sent to the Republic of Kyrgyzstan. We believe this was and still is a good choice.

Kyrgyzstan is the smallest of fifteen independent states formed from the former Soviet Union. It is a Republic, slightly smaller than the state of South Dakota, with a population of 5.4 million. It is an isolated, mountainous, land-locked country in central Asia. It is breathtakingly beautiful with colossal mountains, rivers, lakes and forests. The people, however, live on the plains, only ten percent of the land.

The people are very diverse with 80 different cultures. They have two major religions, 75 percent are Muslim and 20 percent are Russian Orthodox. It is a beautiful land with many poor people. Fifty percent of the population is below the poverty line. Sixty percent of the people do not have their own home but co-exist in someone else's home or apartment. As many as 20 live in a two room house. It has one of the lowest per capita incomes and the highest infant mortality rates anywhere in the world.

Kyrgyzstan is a country in transition. It is a young country, only sixteen years old, with a poor economy and an unstable government. In March of 2005, they had a revolution, but in four months had their first democratic & transparent election which resulted in a new president. They are hard working, resilient people. Since becoming a Habitat affiliate in 1999, they have built or renovated 166 houses and apartments. Their 2007 goal is to build 31 half builds, renovate 8 apartments, and build 10 cane reed houses. A "half build" is a house half done but livable which will be completed later, enabling more people to have a heated home during their harsh winters. The "cane reed" house is a house built using local cane reeds that are woven to fill a timber frame and fortified with clay. These innovative people used this 19<sup>th</sup> century technique to develop a cheaper, easier to build, as well as environmentally friendly house. In 2006, HFH Kyrgyzstan won a prestigious award from The World Bank for their "cane reed" house.

The cost of a Habitat house in Kyrgyzstan is between \$8,000 & \$10,000. With every third house we build in Hood County, our tithe makes possible a house in Kyrgyzstan. But there is more to this story. Marat Jidbaev, Kyrgyzstan HFH executive director, told us that during Soviet control, no one was allowed to leave his country and people were not allowed to come into the country so that they did not know any Americans. "Now we know you and we like you. We need money but we also need to know more about each other. Knowing that you care and help, makes the hard work seem easier, rough life becomes more joyful and new hope emerges for a better future." OUR TITHE IS IN GOOD HANDS. - Phyllis Anderson
